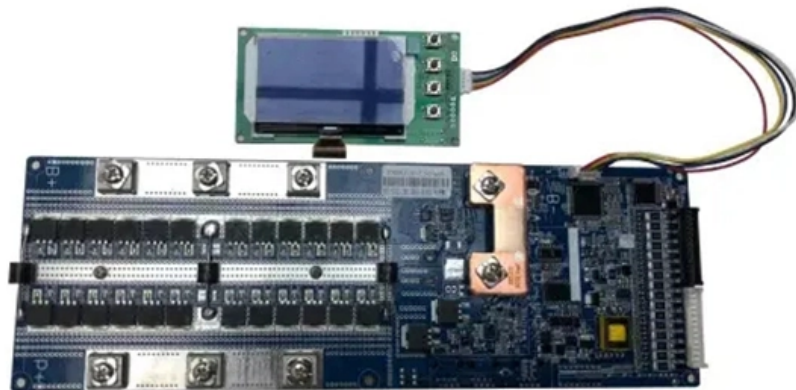

Final cable tray width = Initial cable tray width $\times$ (1 + Expansion percentage)

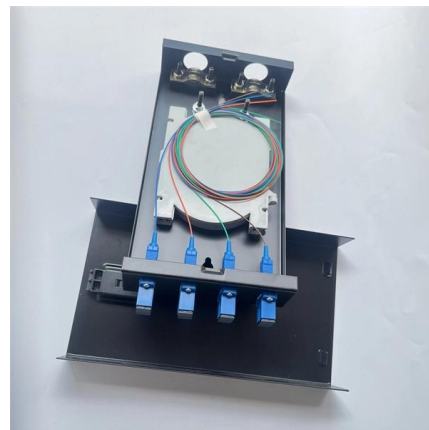

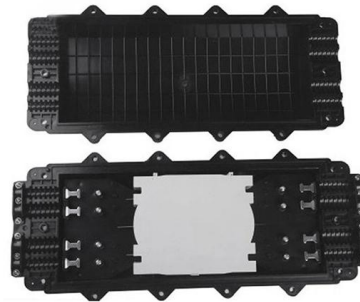

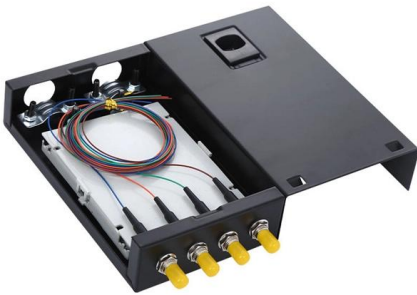
