On horizontal cable trays, laid flat cables are fixed in group (one fastening for every two or three meters). On pipe racks, cable tray shall run on the top most level (s).

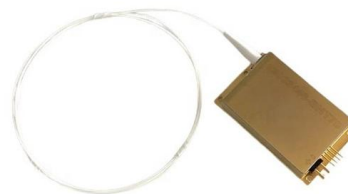
