Overview

Support spacing for cable trays must align with the manufacturer's instructions, as outlined in NEC 392. Generally, standard trays require supports every 6 to 10 feet, while heavy-duty, long-span trays can handle distances of up to 20 feet between supports. The spacing between trays, whether horizontal or vertical, depends on various factors like cable type, environment, and tray material. Where shorter length products are packed in bundles, they shall be supported with a minimum of two timber bearers which provide sufficient clearance to accommodate the forks of a forklift truck.

Precautions for Cable Tray Installation

When multi-layer installation of cable trays for laying cables of 10 kV and above, the spacing between layers is generally not less than 300 mm. The distance from the

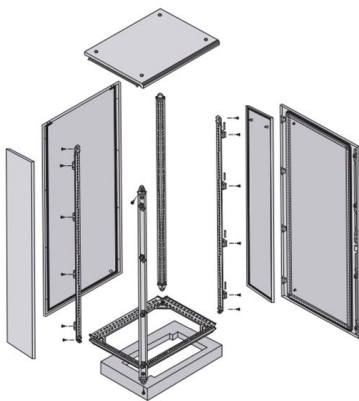

The mesh cable trays are suitable for the installation of power cables and cables in various areas of application. The grid spacings mean that cables can be inserted and run out in various directions.

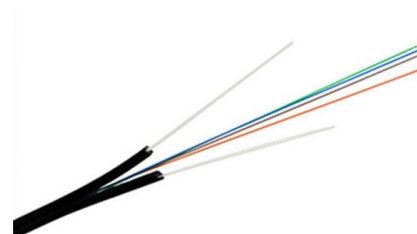

As per the NEC, the maximum allowable rung spacing is 9 inches (230 mm) when cable tray carries sin-gle-conductor cables of 1/0 to 4/0 AWG (American Wire Gauge) (Appendix I).

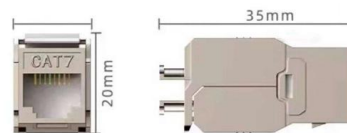
