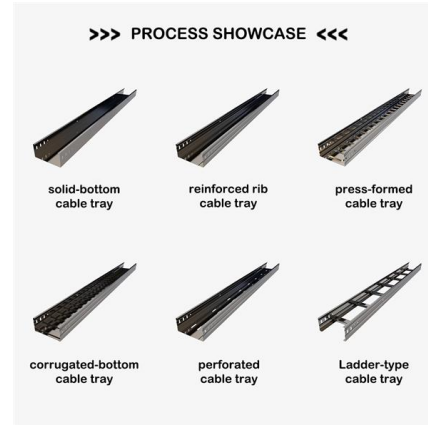


Wiring requirements of distribution box
