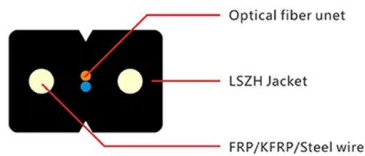
Overview

1) Generally, the incoming line of power distribution box adopts five wire system, that is, a, B and C three-way phase line (the general color is yellow, green and red), one way zero line (the color is light blue) and one way ground line (the color is yellow). They make it easy to identify immediately which wires are live, neutral, or grounded (avoiding costly mistakes and hazardous accidents).
