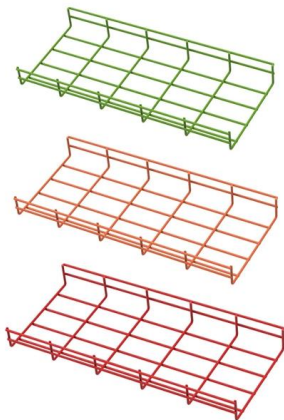

For every 2X increase in split ratio, power is reduced by roughly 3 dB. In most cases, the power out of each leg is equal, but we'll discuss a version where the power coming out is unequal amongst legs.

Use one cable for two network connections with an Ethernet Splitter. Forward or repeat traffic and connect multiple computers with a Network Switch or Hub.

Testing Fiber Optic Couplers, Splitters Or Other Passive

Shown below is a simple 1X2 splitter with one input and two outputs. Basically, in one direction it splits the signal into 2 parts to couple to two fibers.



When using a splitter does the signal still get split 3 ways

If you install an 8-way splitter and you only use 3 ports, you will have more signal loss on each cable versus installing a 3-way splitter. Choose a splitter with the least amount of ports to get the job done.



Port Splitting Configurations

In this configuration, the device can be configured to support eight 100GbE Ethernet ports, with four ports per module. The configuration is illustrated in the diagram below.

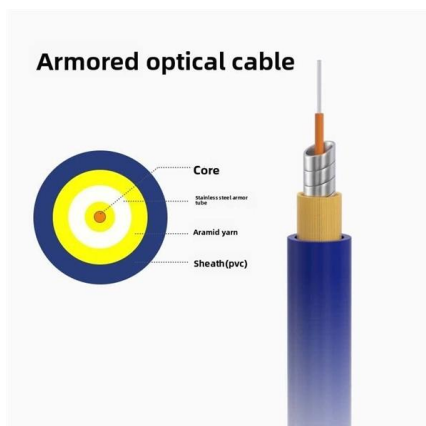
