Although a Cisco switch is a much simpler network device compared with other devices (such as routers and firewalls for example), many people have difficulties to configure a Cisco Catalyst Switch. After network connectivity has been verified, you will use IOS commands to retrieve information from the devices to answer questions about your network equipment.
