Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). Safety of Personnel: By safely channeling fault currents into the ground, proper grounding helps to reduce the risk of electric shock to personnel. Preparation: First, you need to prepare some necessary tools, including grounding wire, grounding rod, voltmeter, insulating gloves and insulating tools. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

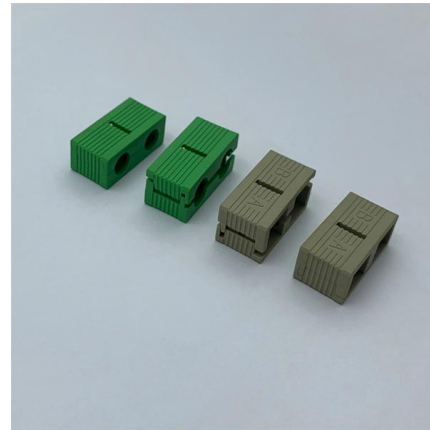

Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.



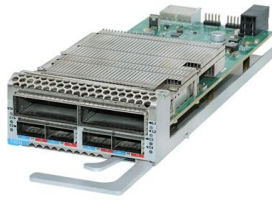
