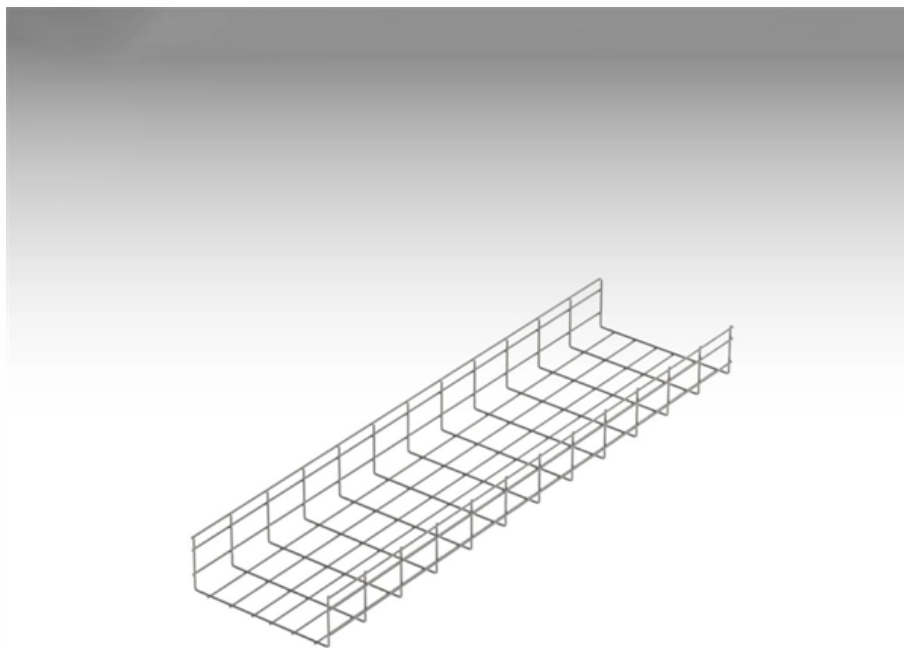

This standard describes requirements for numbering and labeling of real property electrical distribution equipment, circuits, and site lighting at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory. Every home relies on a breaker box (also called a service panel or distribution board) to manage and protect its electrical circuits. If panels and disconnects are mislabelled or not labelled at all, an electrician may be compelled to open disconnect switches.
