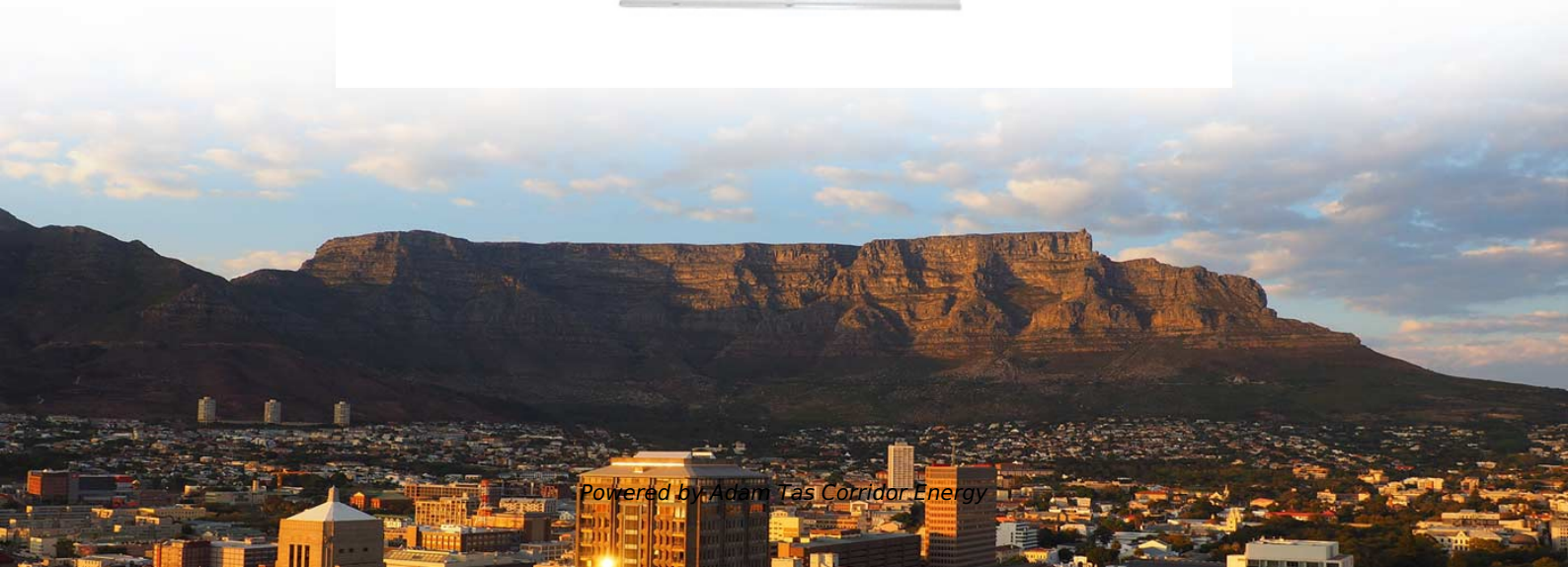

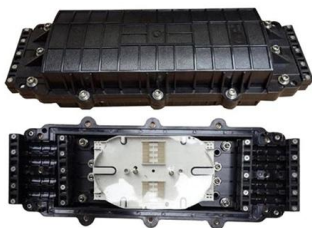

it splits the signal into 2 parts to couple to two fibers.

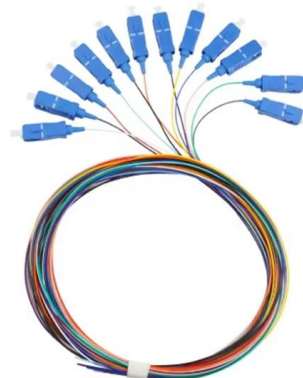

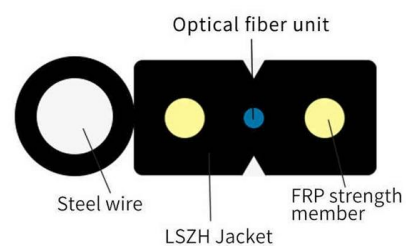

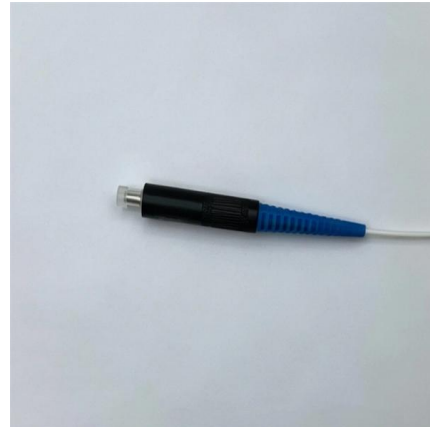
