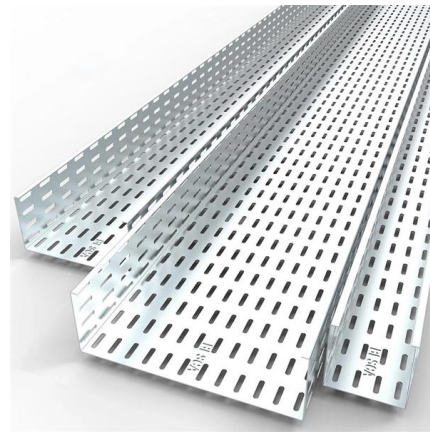

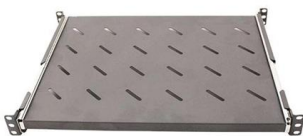


Implementation

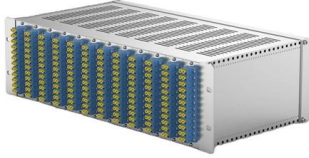

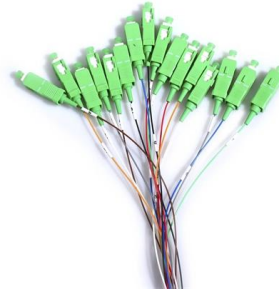
