When you look at 8, 12, 16, and 24 fiber MPO connectors, you can see they have different numbers of fibers and designs. The number of fibers changes how you set up your network and how much you can grow it later. MTP/MPO trunk cables, typically used for creating backbone and horizontal interconnections, have an MTP/MPO connector on both ends and are available from 8 fibers up to 48 in one cable.
