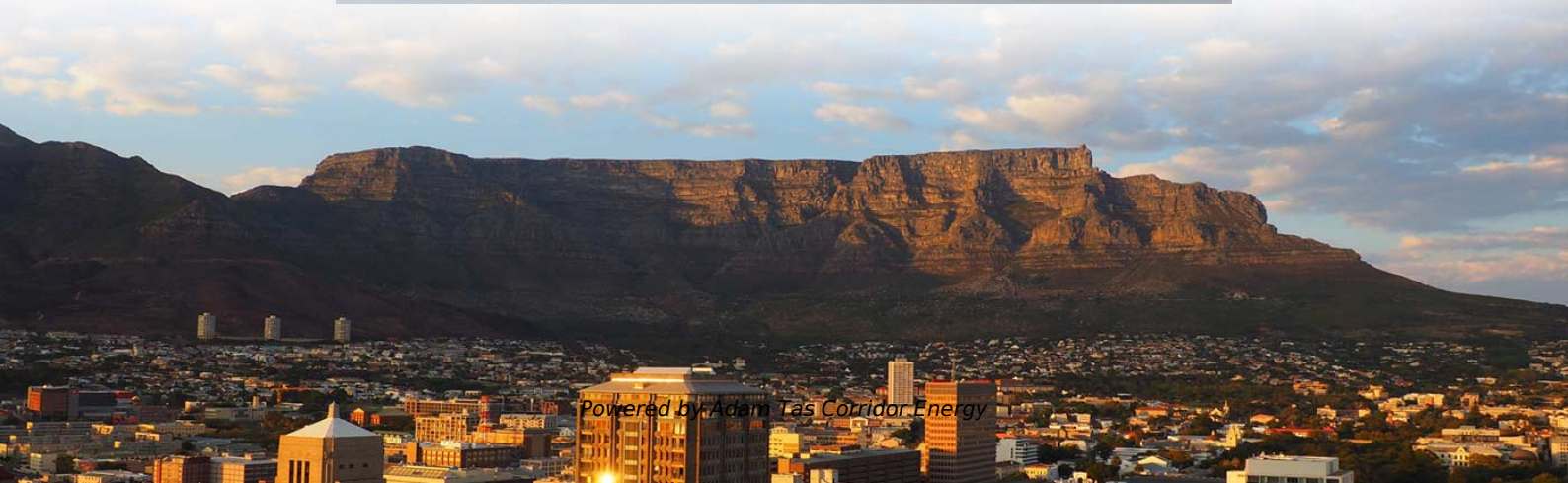

Overview

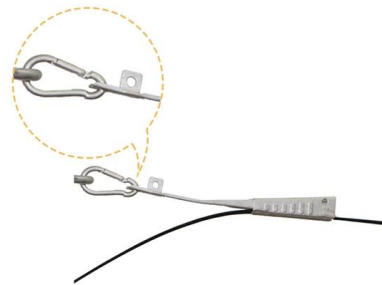

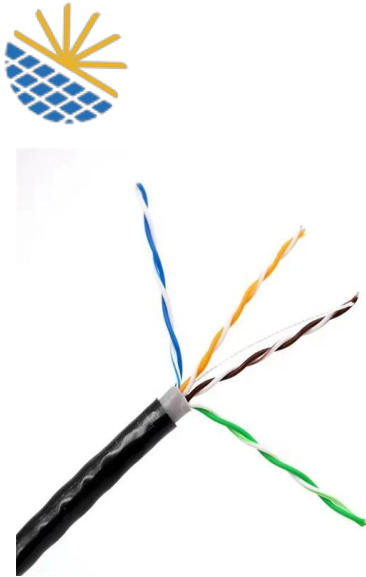
