How to identify the model number on the distribution box





Overview

Carefully open the door of the circuit breaker distribution panel and look for any labels inside that offer model numbers or specifications. To find the part number for BR / CH load centers (residential panels), follow these steps: Remove the front door and the "dead front" cover to access the inside of the panel. It is usually located in a utility room, basement, garage, or occasionally outside. Major manufacturers like Square D are easy to recognize, but obscure and defunct brands of a bygone era can be problematic. How often should I check or update my labels?

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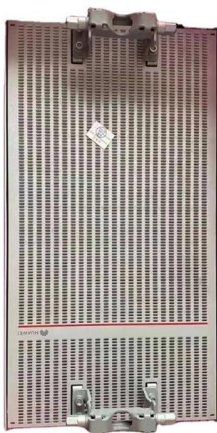

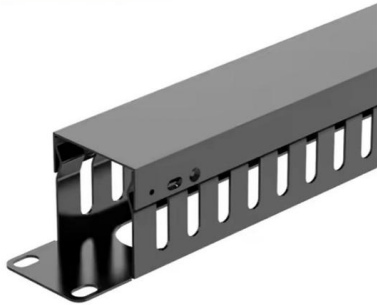

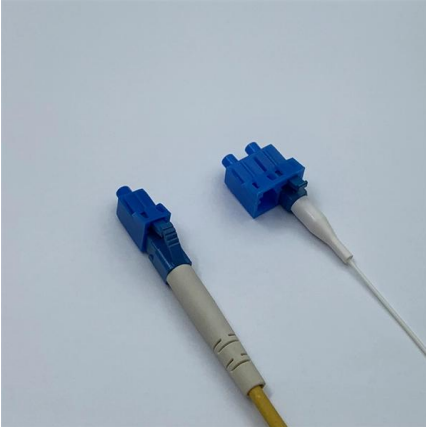
