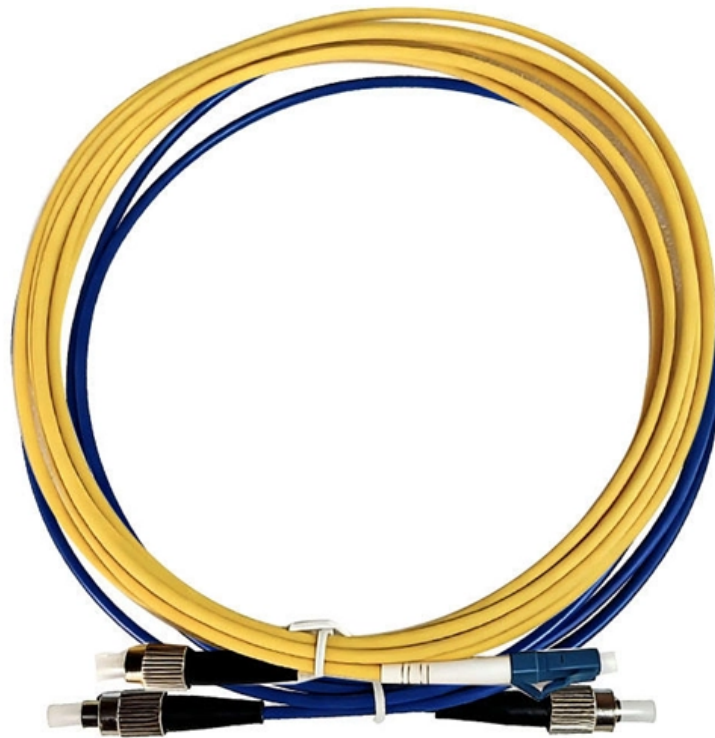

## Overview

---

Various providers have been particularly active in cable deployments at the start of 2025, including a new route from Cirion between Mexico City and the data centre hub of Quer'taro and an additional 2,500km route from C3ntro between Arizona and Quer'taro announced in May 2025. Telmex, Mexico's leading telecommunications provider, has inaugurated the TM5X submarine cable, a significant infrastructure project designed to enhance internet connectivity between Baja California Sur and Sinaloa. C3ntro secured US\$70 million from PROPARCO and DEG to expand a cross-border fiber optic corridor between Mexico and the United States, strengthening connectivity for data centers, AI, and nearshoring-driven digital demand. For example, Cisco's updated Mobility Services Platform and Programmable Core presents communication service providers (CSPs) and enterprises with new ways to scale different terprise data. Flexible equipment ensures efficient management of these diverse demands, optimizing. The first of its kind in 25 years, the long haul fiber network will connect Phoenix and Querétaro with cutting-edge, low latency fiber infrastructure, ready for service in Q4 2026 Mexico City, April 29, 2025 – C3ntro Telecom (C3ntro), a leader in global telecommunications and fiber infrastructure.
