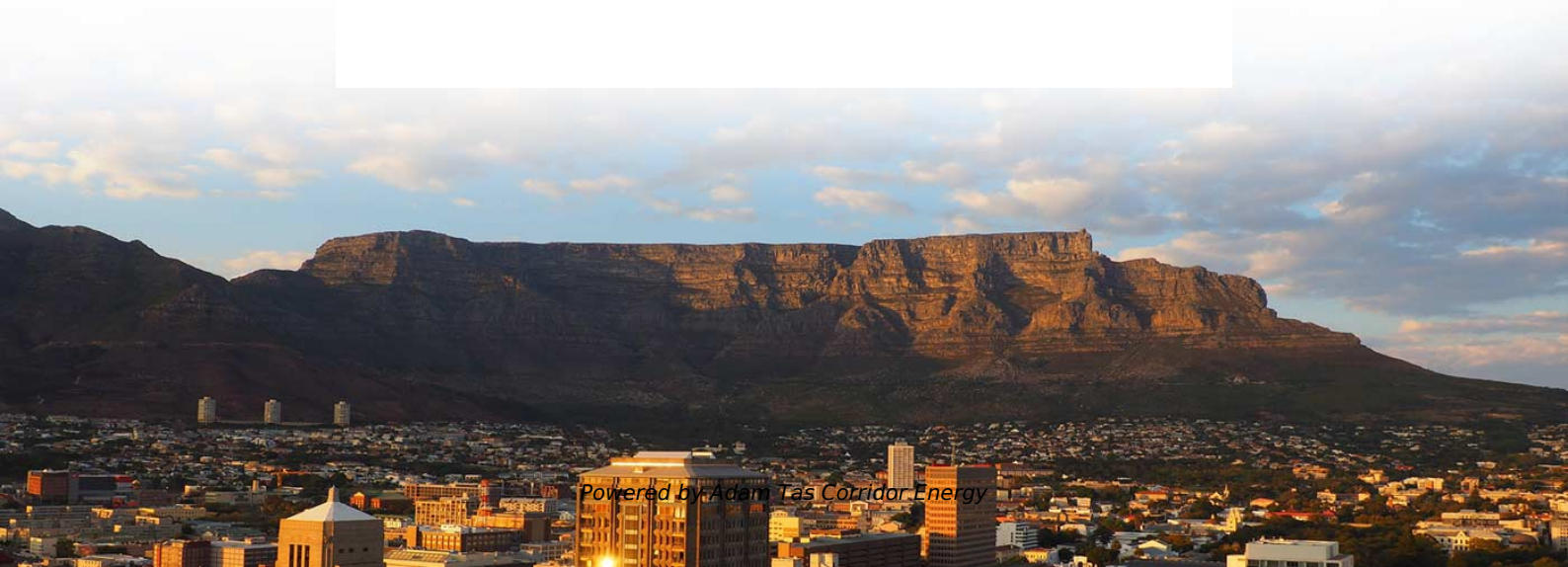

Lighting Standards for Main Distribution Boxes at Construction Sites

This fact sheet explains how to apply the requirements shown in AS/NZS 3012:2019 Electrical installations – construction and demolition sites (AS/NZS 3012:2019), which is called up as a mandatory standard by section 163 of the Work Health and Safety Regulation 2025 (WHS Regulation). This guidance is aimed at those responsible for planning and subsequent management, and those who control the installation and use of electrical systems and equipment on construction sites. Construction areas, ramps, runways, corridors, offices, shops, and storage areas shall be lighted to not less than the minimum illumination intensities listed in Table D-3 while any work is in progress: TABLE D-3 - MINIMUM ILLUMINATION INTENSITIES IN FOOT-CANDLES Foot-candles | Area or operation. These schemes utilise LED luminaires and cross refer to the light levels recommended in BS EN 12464-2 for Building Sites, Table 5.
