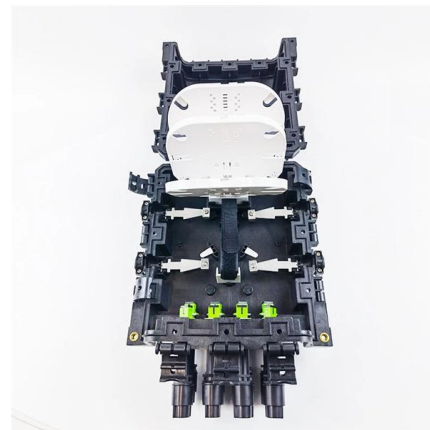


Why do pigtails not count towards box volume capacity

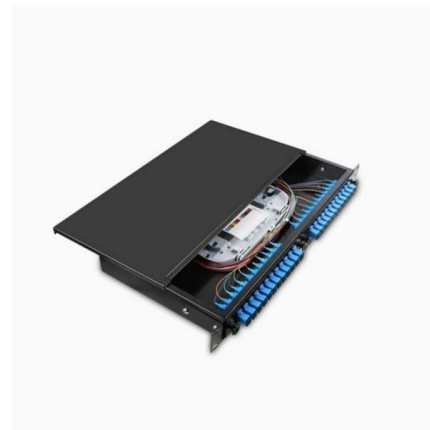

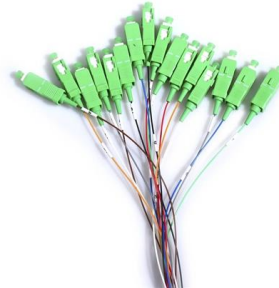

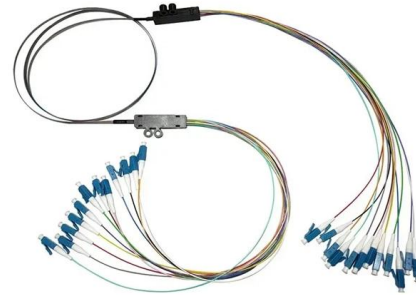
Connections among Fiber Terminal Boxes & Patch

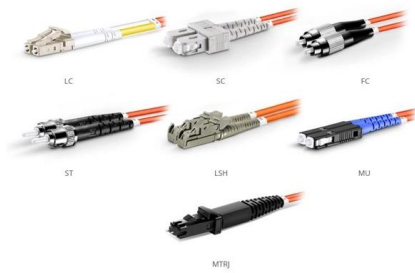

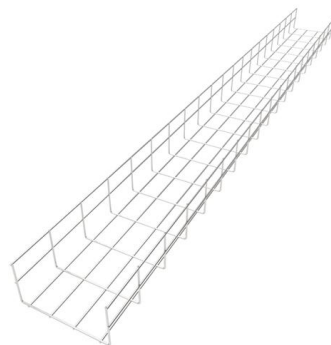
