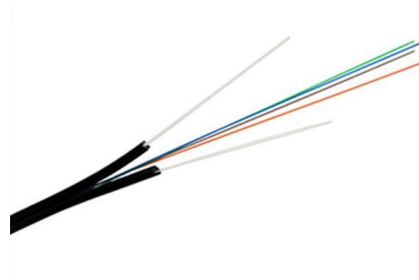
Africa Telecom Transmission Map
