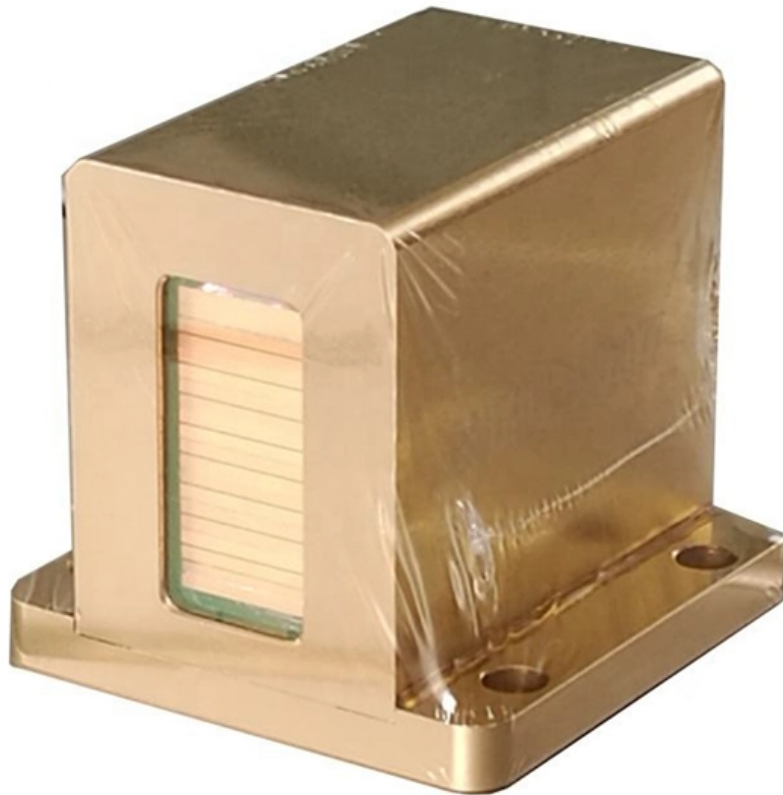

Overview

Cold, damp weather and falling air pressure can stiffen muscles, thicken joint fluid, and heighten sensitivity in irritated joints. Keep warm, move often, and use simple joint-care habits; seek medical advice if pain. It's not uncommon to have joint pain when it's cold, and there are many potential causes. Many people with health conditions such as arthritis report worsening joint pain when. " This common discomfort is a real phenomenon, though the sensation usually originates in the surrounding soft tissues and joints, not the bone structure itself.
