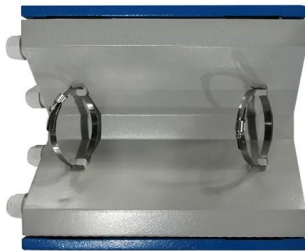

The metal frame of the distribution box must be reliably grounded (PE) or grounded (pen); The door equipped with electrical appliances shall be connected with bare braided copper wire and marked between the grounding terminals of the door and the door frame. How should I wire a construction switchboard when the supply has 3 phases and neutral but no separate ground: bridge PE to N, add grounding, or rely on an RCD?

If the supply is TN-C with a PEN conductor, bring the PEN to the construction switchboard and split it into separate N and PE there; do not. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. On the US market, a 5.26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used.

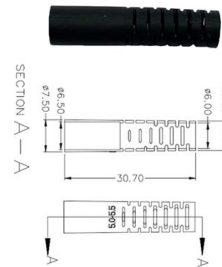

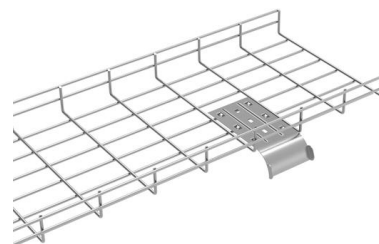
