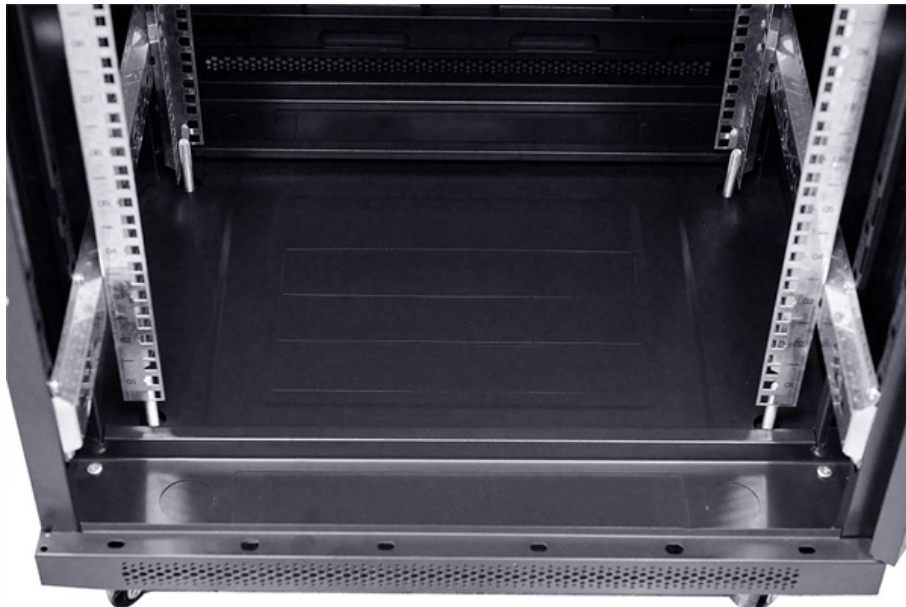

A generic guideline developed by the Cable Tray Institute indicates that cable trays should not be filled in excess of 40-50% of the inside area of the tray or of the tray's maximum weight based on the cable tray specifications. The fill rules differ significantly between single-conductor cables and multiconductor cables, and between ladder tray and solid-bottom tray. 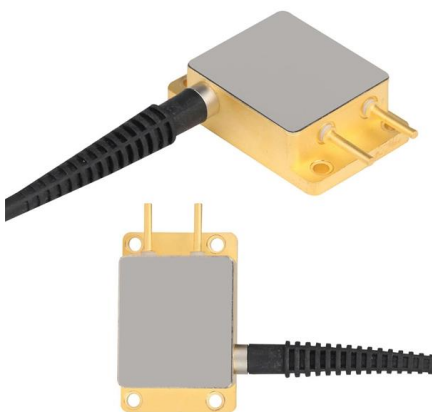

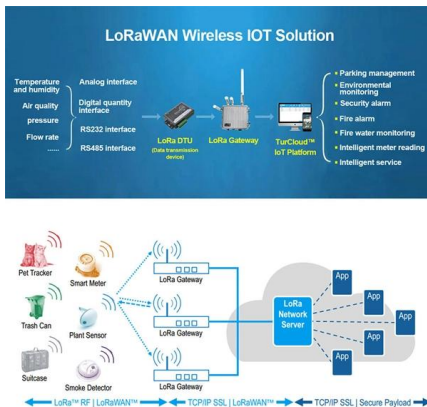

When a tray contains too many cables, the heat is not allowed to get out, which can destroy the wires or even catch fire.

(1) Ladder or Ventilated Trough Cable Trays

For cables 1000 kcmil or larger, they must fit within the tray width in a single layer. For cables between 250 kcmil and 900 kcmil, the total cross-sectional area must not exceed specified limits.

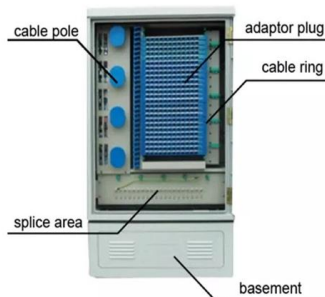

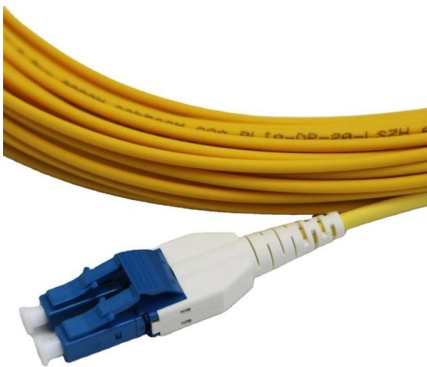
