Overview

Communications cables are run just below the raised floor and to the rear of the equipment cabinet, in the hot aisle. A cable support system consists of cable support lengths and system components, such as cable support fittings, support elements, mounting elements and system accessories. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is used for instrumentation and control applications that require. 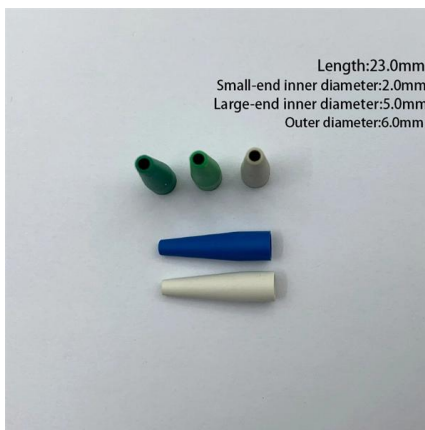
