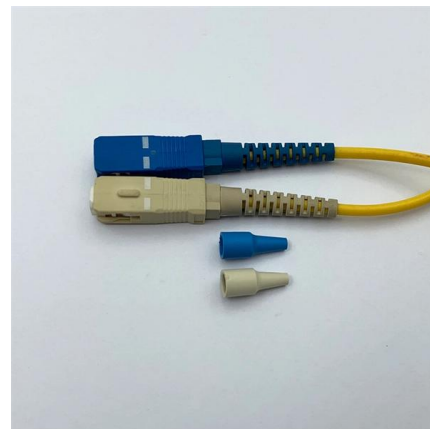

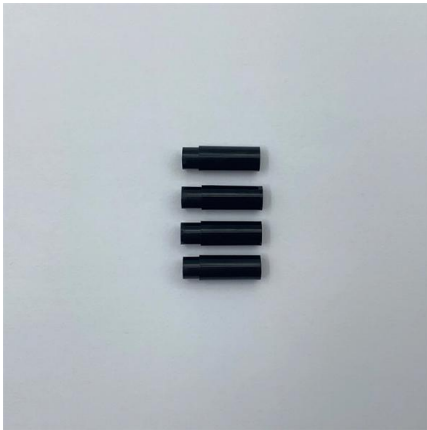

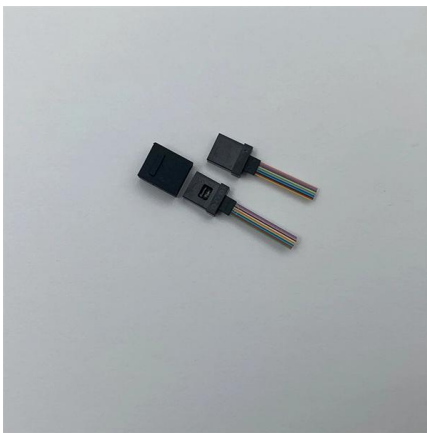

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Cable or "P" clamps and plastic tie wraps are used to fasten cables/conductors to the ladder tray. Single conductors must be fastened to prevent excessive movement generated by fault current magnetic



CABLE TRAY

Cables may be fastened to the cable tray by means of cable clamps or cable ties (See Figures 5.7 and 5.8). Generally, cables are fastened every 450 mm (18 in.) on vertical runs.
