Overview

Industry standards often recommend at least 300mm (12 inches) of spacing between power and control trays to minimize EMI. The primary reason for this separation is to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI), which could. After cable laying, the deflection of the cable tray should not exceed 1/200 of the span of the cable tray.

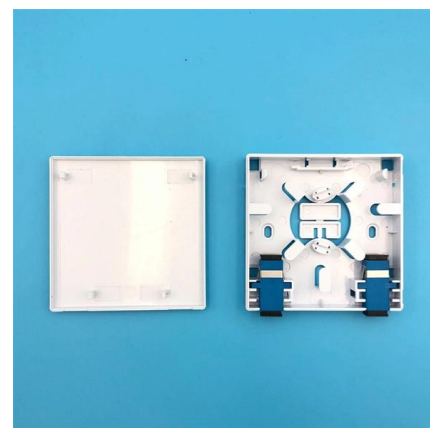
