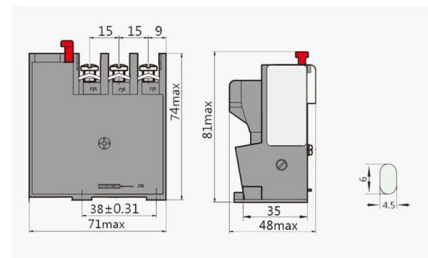

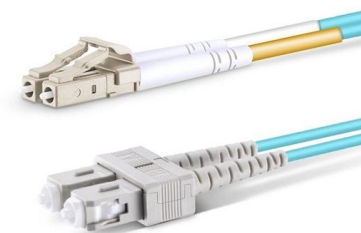

Metal boxes need grounded pigtails using green screws or ground clips. Plastic boxes don't require grounding but still need secure connections to prevent arcing.



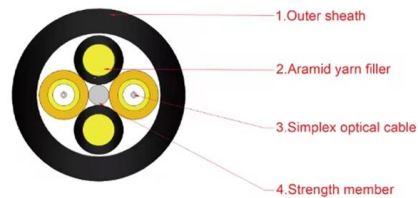


How to Properly Pigtail Outlets for Safety
