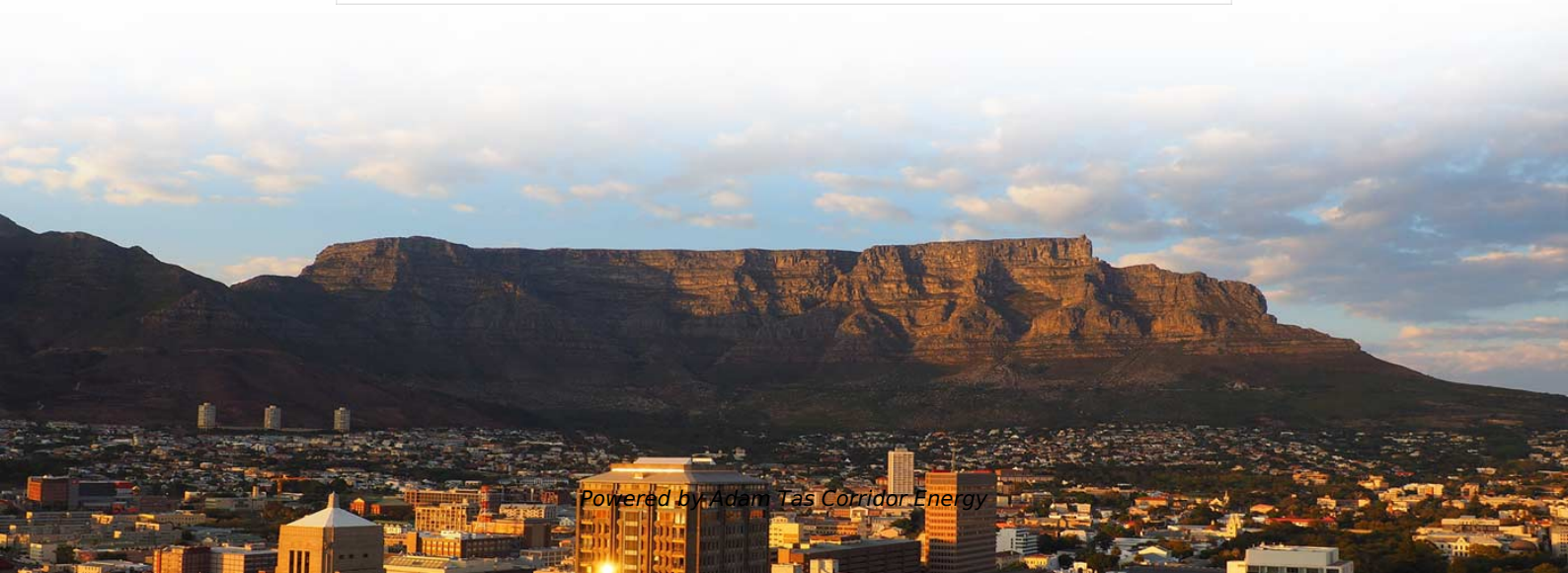

Optical Fiber

To connect a fiber, align the optical connector with the optical port and gently insert the optical fiber into the port. To remove a fiber, press the clip on the connector and pull the fiber out.
