Will the neutral wire in the distribution box be live





Overview

Although it is grounded at the transformer's neutral point, as long as current flows in the circuit, there will be voltage present across portions of the line.

Live (L) Wire Connection: In a distribution box setup, the incoming live wire (also known as phase or hot wire, denoted as L or Line) connects to the line terminal of the circuit breaker. The cables incoming top right are UK old-style (red=live, black=neutral), the cables leaving top and bottom left are EU new-style (brown=live, blue=neutral). The whole place was largely rewired a decade or so ago, which explains the mismatch. If the Neutral Conductor is opened, broke or lost at either of its source side (distribution transformer, generator) or at load side (distribution panel of a consumer), the distribution system's neutral conductor will "float" or lose its reference ground Point.
